

Workplace Charging With Plug-N-Go



Background

By 2040, the sale of petrol and diesel vehicles will be banned in the United Kingdom. To help reduce levels of air pollution and tackle the climate crisis, the UK government offers several incentives for driving electric vehicles. Workplace charging is a key element of this, as outlined by a leading charge point locator, Zap-Map:

“The Government offers businesses, organisations, charities, and local authorities financial support to have charge points installed at their premises under the Workplace Charging Scheme (WCS)”.

“The grant provides £500 (inc VAT) per socket up to 75% of the total cost of installation – up to a maximum of 20 sockets – to be installed on dedicated off-street parking for staff or fleet use.”

As well as the grant to subsidise the cost of EV charging at work, electric vehicles will benefit from a 0% Benefit-In-Kind rate from April 2020. The current UK rate for ICE vehicles averages at 28%. Providing EV charging to staff is also exempt from Benefit-In-Kind.

Furthermore, a salary sacrifice scheme allows for staff leasing an EV through their workplace to pay through their salary, deducting it from their gross earnings each month. This lowers taxable income, resulting in significant savings.


